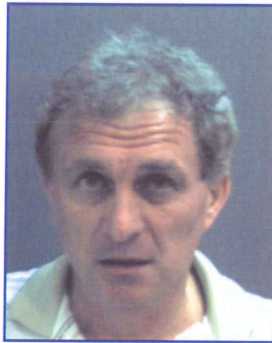

Mladen Antolic, M.D. Arrested for Possession of Alprazolam
Orlando Physician - Owner of Local Pain Management Clinic
December 13, 2010

On December 13, 2010, agents with the Metropolitan Bureau of Investigation (MBI) **arrested** and charged **Mladen Antolic, M.D.** with **Possession of Alprazolam**. Today's arrest stems from the October 27, 2010, search of Mladen Antolic's residence.

On October 27, 2010, agents with the **Metropolitan Bureau of Investigation (MBI)/Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE)** executed a court-ordered search warrant at **3868 Hunters Isle Drive, Orlando, Florida**, the residence of **Mladen Antolic, M.D.** An investigation began after several persons came forward to report that **Mladen Antolic, M.D.** was illegally distributing prescription drugs from his home.

Mladen Antolic, owns and operates the **Injury Mid Florida Rehabilitation, 509 W. Colonial Drive, Orlando, Florida** which is a registered Pain Management Clinic with the State of Florida.

The October 27, 2010, search of **Mladen Antolic's** house revealed **34 grams of Cocaine**, approximately **1500 Oxycodone pills**, and approximately **250 Alprazolam bars**. In addition, **five handguns**, approximately **\$40,000 U.S. currency**, and an **electronic money counter**, utilized to sort large amounts of cash, were seized from the residence. **Mladen Antolic** was **arrested** and charged with **Trafficking in Cocaine** and **Trafficking in Oxycodone**.

This is an on-going investigation. **MBI/FDLE** requests that anyone with additional information related to **Mladen Antolic** is urged to contact **MBI/FDLE** at 407-836-9701.
